

Five Round Swiss System—Number of rounds may change depending upon entrants Participants will play every round—no player eliminated

Divisions may be combined depending upon number of entrants

Players to bring their own Equipment—boards, clocks, and sets

Time Controls 6th and under Division G30/SD 5 second delay All other Divisions G40/SD 5 second delay

Special Note about Team Competition:

This informal team competition is designed to encourage parent/grandparent/guardian/youth leader/coach interaction with those youth entrusted to their care in a fun setting. Players who wish to participate in the team competition portion of the event should select a team captain who will select a team name and who will create a listing of all players on their team (no limit to the number of team members!). This listing is to be given by the team captain to the tournament directors at the time they check in for the event.

Players will earn points for their respective team based on the results of their individual play each round (1 point for win/0 points for loss/.50 point for a draw). Cumulative point totals for each team will be posted each round. The team with the total number of cumulative points at the end of the tournament will earn the team championship award. Awards will be given to the top three teams on the day. Should there be a tie in points by teams at the end of the event, then each team captain will select a player to compete against the other team's player of choice and those players will play a 5-minute sudden death blitz chess match to determine their team placing.
